Installation

The program is self-installing after placement into your CD-ROM disk drive. It is designed to run under the MAC and Windows XP©, Windows Vista and WIN 7© environments for PCs; with Adobe©. The program is not designed to be run from a network server and should be loaded on a stand-alone computer, MAC or laptop (PC). **It is self-loading.**

Using the Medical Office Checklist Compendium on CD-ROM Software©

The software is divided into multiple areas with individual .PDF icon-labeled topics. Simply use arrow keys, a pointer or mouse to highlight the subject area that you desire and press the "Enter" key or the "left button" on the mouse. Some subjects are further broken down into different parts to read. Choose the .PDF icon you want to study and press "Enter" or the "left mouse button".
